SUBJECT: Underground Utilities Construction
Rowland, Inc. Performance

This simply acknowledges that Rowland, Inc., 6855 102nd Avenue N., Pinellas Park, FL has, within the past several years, completed a number of major underground utilities construction projects for the City of Dunedin. Rowland's work has consistently been completed on time and within budget and in full cooperation with City and regulatory agency requirements. Rowland's recent major work for the City included the emergency repair and reconstruction of the Dunedin Causeway waterline, in early 2010, and the emergency reconstruction of the main gravity interceptor sewer at the City's wastewater treatment plant in mid-2008. At this time, we anticipate the City commission will award, on March 3, 2011, a new contract to Rowland, Inc., for the replacement of about 2.9 miles of potable water supply and sanitary force main pipelines along the Dunedin Causeway.

Rowland's project work has been completed in a very responsive and responsible manner.

Rowland's pricing, cooperation with residents and utility system customers, and overall positive performance have exceeded City requirements.
